

Cast Care Instructions:

- 1. Elevate the cast above chest level to lessen swelling for the first 24-48 hrs.
- 2. Apply ice pack for pain and swelling.
- 3. Do not wet cast.
- 4. Maintain cast clean and dry.
- 5. Do not place any objects into the cast.
- 6. Do not put pressure or weight on the cast for 24 hours until it hardens.
- 7. Follow doctors' advice regarding your cast treatment.

What to watch for:

- 1. Tingling or numbness in fingers or toes that does not resolve.
- Discoloration of toe or fingers to blue or white that does not resolve. Check circulation by pressing the nails to see if color returns immediately.
- Severe constant pain that does not respond to ice, elevation and your prescribed medications.
- 4. Excessive swelling or inability to move fingers or toes.
- 5. Excessive muscle cramping, tightness, or pressure under the cast.
